

# Harry Sands Memorial Table Tennis Teams Championship

**When:** Saturday, January 24, 2015 - 10:00 AM

**What:** To determine the best table tennis team in the tri-state area.

**Where:** Charleston, WV. At the North Charleston Community Center located at 2009 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Charleston, WV 25312. Facility Phone – (304) 348-6884 (**Google Map Search: North Charleston Recreation Center 25312**)

**Sponsored by:** Charleston Table Tennis Club

*This is an unsanctioned tournament. No USATT ratings will be generated or updated from playing in this tournament.*

**Tournament Director:** Dale Goff (304) 415-8685

**Eligibility:** Open

**Play Format:** Teams comprised of not less than 3 participants will engage in an Inter-City team table tennis competition, additional pre-registered participants will be permitted but limited to not more than 5 per team.

*The format of play is adopted from the USATT Team Play Score sheet which indicates a team winning a contest, is the result of at least two players from each team playing 2 singles matches and a double match against the corresponding players from another team. (Defined as a contest) The same player may not compete in consecutive singles matches, within that contest.*

*Order of play will be 2 singles matches and a doubles match followed by additional single matches until a best 3 out of 5 for that contest has been achieved. Play will stop when the contest has been decided.*

*The tournament will involve all registered teams competing against each of the other registered teams for one contest each. Winning a contest is determined by the best three out of 5 matches. A match is determined by the first player to win 3 out of 5 games. The games will be played to 11 win by 2. USATT rules will apply. The overall won/loss record and applicable tie breaker criteria (if necessary) will determine the tournament champion. If the number of registered teams exceeds 12 teams at the close of registration (9:45 am) A determination to divide the field of competing teams into equal/practical sets, paired at random by lot, and then the two best won/loss record achieving from each grouping will advance to a final contest to determine the tournament champion.*

**Starting time:** 10:00 AM

**Doors Open:** The doors will open 9:00 AM.

**Lunch:** Pizza and Drinks will be provided for lunch - served in the storage area.

**Equipment:** Only USATT approved equipment will be used. Eight Butterfly Tables, Butterfly Barriers and Butterfly 3 star white balls.

**Rules:** All USATT rules and regulations apply including USATT dress code.

**Special Note:** Players must be on their best behavior at all times. No bad behavior will be tolerated.

**Playing Conditions:** North Charleston Community Center Basketball Court. No street shoes!  
(**NO** food or drink in the Gymnasium, only permitted in the storage area)

**Registration Start & Deadline:** Registrations accepted starting January 5, 2015 and continue through 1 half hour before tournament start time. (Saturday January 24, 2015 @ 9:30 AM)

**Entry Fee:** \$30.00 per team (Regardless of number of players per team)

Turn <b>left</b> at <b>Iowa St</b>	(go 0.1 mi.)

Merge onto <b>US-119 S/Bigley Ave</b>	(go 0.2 mi.)
Slight <b>left</b> at <b>Pennsylvania St</b>	(go 0.2 mi.)
Turn <b>right</b> at <b>Washington St. W</b>	(go 1.8 mi.)
Turn <b>left</b> at <b>Iowa St</b>	(go 0.1 mi.)
Take the <b>right</b> onto <b>7<sup>th</sup> Ave</b>	(go 0.1 mi.)
Turn <b>Left</b> at <b>2 St. W</b>	(go 289 ft.)

Take exit <b>58C</b> toward <b>US-60/WashingtonSt/Civic Center</b>	(go (0.2 mi)
Merge onto <b>US-119 S/Bigley Ave</b>	(go 0.2 mi.)
Slight <b>left</b> at <b>Pennsylvania St</b>	(go 0.2 mi.)
Turn <b>right</b> at <b>Washington St. W</b>	(go 1.8 mi.)
Turn <b>left</b> at <b>Iowa St</b>	(go 0.1 mi.)

Take <b>exit 56</b> for <b>Montrose Dr.</b>	(go 0.2 mi.)
Turn <b>right</b> at <b>Montrose Dr.</b>	(go 0.3 mi.)
Turn <b>right</b> at <b>Maccorkle Ave SW</b>	(go 0.9 mi.)
Keep <b>left</b> at the fork, follow signs for <b>US-60 E</b> across bridge	(go 0.7 mi.)
Continue to follow signs for <b>US-60 E</b> in left lane	
Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>7<sup>th</sup> Ave</b>	(go 0.3 mi.)
Turn <b>Left</b> at <b>2 St. W</b>	(go 289 ft.)
